Multiple Position Vacancy Announcement: Arkansas Department of Health

The Arkansas Department of Health is recruiting twelve epidemiologists (Senior Epidemiologists, Grade 22).

You will be considered for all twelve jobs if you apply for one. These announcements **close on 14Feb03**, so your application must be received by COB of this date.

Five of these are **leadership** positions in the state's public health **regions**. It is expected that these individuals will reside in the region and serve as a member of the regional leadership team, as well as to provide epidemiological support, especially in **bioterrorism preparedness**, to the region. If you are interested in these positions, please indicate a willingness to work anywhere in the state.

The other positions are located in Little Rock, Arkansas. We are recruiting epidemiologists for **alcohol and drug abuse prevention, tobacco prevention, hepatitis prevention and control, cancer registry, maternal and child health, family planning** and **bioterrorism preparedness**.

Minimum qualifications include a bachelor's degree in biology or a related field. An MPH with emphasis in epidemiology and two years of experience in a related field are preferred. Well qualified candidates may be eligible for a special entry rate of up to **\$47,500** per year.
